



How to set up your Fur Closet the right way

If you own fur coats, you know how important it is to store them properly to keep them looking luxurious for years. Setting up a Fur Closet isn't just about organization—it's about creating the perfect environment to maintain your furs. Here's a simple, step-by-step guide to help you do it right.

Step 1: Pick the perfect spot

Where you place your fur closet in your home is entirely up to you. The key purpose of a fur closet is to **maintain your fur coats via humidity and temperature control**, so placement in, by example, a sunny area is not a concern. However, **we don't recommend installing the fur closet in a dressing room or bedroom** due to the noise it may generate.

Step 2: Install the Fur Closet

Install the Fur Closet The closet should only be taken out of its packaging. If it has been transported on its side, wait 24 hours before plugging it in. The unit is plug-and-play, requiring no additional installation.

Step 3: Keep it well-ventilated

Good airflow is key to preventing moisture buildup, which can cause mold and deterioration. Do not remove the legs of the closet—they allow air to circulate underneath. Also, make sure there's a 10-centimeter gap between the back and side panels of the closet and the walls to insure proper ventilation.

Step 4: Use strong, supportive hangers

Once your closet is in place, add sturdy, broad-shouldered hangers. Preferably wooden hangers. These will help your coats maintain their shape and avoid unnecessary creasing. Skip thin or wire hangers—they can ruin the structure of your furs over time.

Step 5: Store your fur coats with care

Now that everything is set up, it's time to hang your beautiful fur coats. Make sure they're evenly spaced so air can circulate between them. Avoid overcrowding the closet to prevent flattening and unnecessary wear.
